

THE WOODVILLE TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE'S REGULAR MEETING - August 2, 2017

This regular meeting of the Woodville Township Trustees was held on August 2, 2017. Those in attendance: Trustees: Chairman Bill Hammer, Paul Heineman, Ken Green (arrived at 7:15 pm due to a train blocking the crossing), Fiscal Officer Lori Kepus, Road Supervisor Jim Busdiecker, Zoning Inspector Steve Michaelis, Fire Chief Bill Andrews, Assistant Fire Chief Dave Miller, Fire Captain Joe Kopp (arrived at 7:15 pm due to a train blocking the crossing) and Paramedic Jeff Herman.

Trustee Hammer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Trustee Green made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 19, 2017 regular meeting. Trustee Heineman seconded. All answered yes to roll call. Motion passed. Trustee Heineman made a motion to approve the warrants. Trustee Green seconded. All answered yes to roll call. Motion passed.

EMS – Chief Andrews is working on a dispatching issue on turnpike calls while the turnpike is under construction.

The starter and exhaust system on LS91 was replaced. The repair bill from W.W. Williams was \$3,780.95.

ZONING – Zoning Inspector Steve Michaelis presented one approved zoning permit for Dean Anstead, 6723 CR 107 Gibsonburg, for a 48' x 56' building addition with a 48' x 12' patio. The \$50 permit fee was paid.

CEMETERY – Township worker Dave Busdiecker continues mowing. The prisoners from the Sandusky County Sheriff's office Community Work Program were at the cemeteries trimming last week and did the best job yet!

ROADS – Road Supervisor Jim Busdiecker reported that he has busy road mowing and trimming brush back with the boom mower.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

FISCAL OFFICER – Kepus presented the Trustees with the Township's balanced bank reconciliation for the month of July and the updated Fund, Revenue, and Appropriation status reports.

Kepus presented a draft of a newsletter for review. The Trustees decided to mail this to every resident in the village and township as the information contained in the newsletter would be beneficial to both. Trustee Green made a motion to allow up to \$750 to be spent for the printing and mailing of the newsletter. Trustee Heineman seconded. All answered yes to roll call. Motion passed.

The Woodville Business Association will hold their next meeting at the fire station on August 10 at 7:30 am.

The American Red Cross collected 23 pints of blood at their July 27 bloodmobile that was held at the station. Their next blood drive will be held on October 13.

The Sandusky County Health Department will hold a flu shot clinic at the fire station on October 11 from 1–3 pm.

The Trustees approved a hall use request by fire-fighter Dave Miller for October 1 from 10 am to 5 pm.
